## Additional Learning Needs

As you are aware Mr Roy left FBS at the end of last half-term. Subsequently we have changed the structure of the Additional Learning Needs department, which we are very excited about.

Ms Adams who is a qualified SENco is managing the day to day running of the department and ensuring all the needs of the boys on the register are met. Michelle Coleman comes into school one day a week as a Consultant and Advisor and goes through all our pupil passports, plans and register to ensure that our SEN provision is outstanding. Mr Kellie, one of our Deputy Heads, line manages Ms Adams and Michelle Coleman.

At the moment the Additional Learning Team consists of three Learning Support Assistants and an Intern. We are looking to appoint one more Learning Support Assistant and another Intern will be

joining us after Christmas. Mr Beckford, our part time Art teacher, is also working two days a week as a member of the Additional Learning Needs Team.


