Detentions and internal exclusion

As you know we have very high expectations at The Fulham Boys School and as such we have a strict detention and internal exclusion system. The detention system runs daily and boys are kept behind at school if they accumulate a number of conduct signatures:

2 signatures	10 minute detention with form teacher
4 signatures	15 minute detention with form teacher
6 signatures	20 minute detention with form teacher
8 signatures	30 minute detention with Head of House
10 signatures	45 minute detention with SLT
12 signatures	1hr 15 minute detention with Headmaster on Friday afternoon
16 signatures	1hr 15 minute detention with Headmaster on Friday afternoon
20 signatures	2.5 hour Saturday detention 10-12.30

Please rest assured that this only applies to a small minority of boys and in fact we have a number of boys, even in year 10 who have never received a conduct signature in school.

We also have an internal exclusion room where boys are taught separately to their peers for the day. If placed in internal exclusion the boys will remain in school until 6pm. Boys could be placed in internal exclusion for a variety of reasons including; uniform and appearance infringements, failing to bring essential equipment to school, repeatedly disruptive behaviour in lessons, bringing the school into disrepute etc. Parents and guardians will be informed via email if their son is placed in internal exclusion.

We believe that these sanctions help us to ensure that all boys at FBS maintain the highest possible standards.

Lunchtime Supervisors


