Attendance and Punctuality

As you know at The Fulham Boys School we are keen that all boys have 100% attendance and are on time and ready to learn every day. At present all boys who are late to school in the morning are issued

with a late stamp and a conduct signature, after the Easter holiday we will be introducing a late detention to try to ensure all boys are punctual every day and make sure they catch up on any lost learning time.

- 1 late each half term = only a conduct signature
- 2 = 15 minute break time detention
- 3 = 30 minute after school detention with Head of House
- 4 = a 45 minute after school SLT detention
- 5 = a parental meeting.

You will see if your son has been late to school through the late stamp in his planner. We hope that you will support us in maintaining the highest possible standards of attendance and punctuality.

Sports Afternoon – Summer Term

Summer Term sports afternoons will be taking place at Barn Elms Sports Centre. Boys will be travelling from school via coach at 1:30pm on their designated day for sports. This will continue to be Tuesday for Year 7, Wednesday for Year 8 and Thursday for Year 9.


